On 7 February 2023, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) published a proposal for a ban on the manufacture, use and the sales and marketing of more than 10,000 PFAS, while in November 2023, a new provision of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) came into effect and by which manufacturers must submit details of any PFAS they produced, imported or processed since 1 January 2011, to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
